

# How to Craft an Outline for a 5 Paragraph Essay

A five-paragraph essay has five paragraphs, beginning with an introduction and followed by three main sections (paragraphs) and a conclusion. Among the many various types of essays, you can write a persuasive essay from an [essay writer](#). Other types of essays are the informative essay, the argumentative essay, the expository essay, and the cause-and-effect essay. Now that you have a sense of what this essay is about, examine the five-paragraph essay outline.

It is impossible to overstate the value of an introductory paragraph. An introduction of an essay written by a professional essay writer will do three things: it will attract your reader to learn more; it will provide the necessary context for understanding the issue, and it will lay out a simple argument in favor of the topic "[WriteMyEssay.Help](#)". More importantly, the introduction contains the critical component of the essay - the argument or thesis statement. That will come later; for now, let's focus on the first couple of phrases of the introduction.

After you have attracted your reader's attention, you will go on to the sentence that introduces the context and problem. This is where you will tell your reader critical information about your subject. For instance, you may highlight prior research on the subject and provide a brief background.

Without a thesis statement, you cannot write a good essay, five paragraphs, or otherwise. The phrase is where you will state the article's core concept "[write my paper](#)". You can think of it as a summary of your three body paragraphs that helps you organize your writing into a well-structured, well-flowing piece of work. However, before you write your thesis statement, you should choose three major points that you will explore in your piece. In other types of papers, you can select more or fewer concepts, but with a five-paragraph essay, you don't have an option; you need three body paragraphs, which means three key ideas, each with its own paragraph.

Although body paragraphs are rather straightforward, they must adhere to a specified style. Your body paragraph's opening line should be an intro that connects your key topic to your thesis. This aids in the structure and flow of your essay, while also keeping readers focused on the purpose of your writing.

Finally, bring your body paragraph to a close with a statement that summarizes your major topic and connects it back to the purpose of your essay.
